

SUCCESS RATE


Of 1,574 graduates during the 2017 year, 6.8% of those who responded were not employed or continuing their education.


Employment and Transfer






Gathering Data

The information was collected by the Placement of ces through personal conversations, classroom visits, telephone calls, emails, mailings, texts, and social media.

Wage and employment information has been self-reported by graduates for their first job after graduation. Self-reported continuing education status was supplemented with information from the National Student Clearinghouse.
