

BOARD OF GOVERNORS

A-3 POLICY Election/Oversight

The Board of Governors shall consist of eleven members. Two members shall be elected for staggered four-year terms from each of the five election districts comprising the fifteen county Southeast Community College Area. One member shall be elected at large from the entire Area, for a four-year term.

The Board of Governors shall function as the governing and legislative body of the College and shall conduct itself at all times so as to keep the welfare of the College and the Area foremost in mind. It shall report to the State Board of Education. The Board, or staff member of the College shall have the power to take any action of the Board, without specific approval authorized by the Board, or staff member of the College appearing in the official minutes.
