

STOP York County

You **ARE** eligible to take this class if the citation is for a Minor Traffic Violation. Examples:

- Speeding
- Driving on a suspended license
- Wrong turn
- Failure to yield
- Failure to stop at a stop sign
- Driving on a revoked license
- License expired
- Call /r l r r r
- M l l la r (r l r r a ar)
- Val ' l r r r r r
- N a r a a l
- Val a r r r r l

Attend a 4-hour STOP class and minor traffic violations can be dismissed!

You are **NOT** eligible to take this class if the citation is for a Major Traffic Violation. Examples:

- Speeding 15 mph or more over the limit
- Driving on a suspended license
- Driving on a revoked license
- Driving on a license that has expired

Protect your driving record.

Avoid a court appearance.

Please note: You are **NOT** eligible to take this class if the citation is for a Major Traffic Violation.

You must successfully pass the 4-Hour STOP class within 30 days after you receive the citation or you may become ineligible.

Any violation that results in a suspension or revocation of your license is a major traffic violation.
