The total number of students at Southeast Community College who have been offered an Emergency Financial Aid grant to students under Sections 314(1)(a) of the CRRSAA Act as of April 12, 2021 is 3,722 for a total of \$2,141,218.00.

Following Department of Education guidelines, Southeast Community College determined that students that are eligible for HEERF II funds must meet the following requirements:

Must be enrolled (or have been enrolled) in undergraduate classes during the Spring 2021 semester

Must be a US citizen, permanent resident or eligible non-citizen Must have a valid and completed FAFSA on file with SCC by March 25, 2021 for the purposes of determining financial need

Southeast Community College was required to distribute grant amounts based on a student's demonstrated exceptional financial need. The Department of Education encourages the use of FAFSA data and, more specifically, the student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC) to measure this financial need.

After a review of our student information, Southeast Community College developed the following distribution schedule:
